

GENERAL LIMITATIONS

All users of this range must comply with the limitations noted in the range approvals.

Public Agencies must adhere to the posted range rules, shooting activities and limitations specified in the approvals.

Failure to adhere to the rules and range approvals can result in your removal from the range.

- Full automatic fire is not authorized on this range.
 - .50 BMG is not authorized on this range.
 - All shooting is directed downrange towards the primary backstop.
 - No shooting into or toward side berms.
 - No cross range shooting.
 - All shooting is conducted from the established firing line.
-
- Reactive steel targets are authorized only during sanctioned club matches or events.
 - Personal or home made steel targets are not authorized for use.
 - Steel targets are not authorized on trap ranges.
 - Reactive steel targets must be a minimum distance of 10 metres away from the shooting line for centre fire handgun and all rim fire firearms.
 - Reactive steel targets must be a minimum distance of 50 metres from the firing line for centrefire rifles and shotguns using slugs or steel shot.
 - Reactive steel targets must be a minimum distance of 10 metres from the firing line for shotguns using frangible or lead shot.

As of May 1, 2020 the Federal government declared firearms with a muzzle energy greater than 10,000 J or 7,000 FT-LB to be prohibited.

Most standard rifle calibres are suitable for use at the range as they fall within the ballistic energy parameters of the .338 Lapua template.
